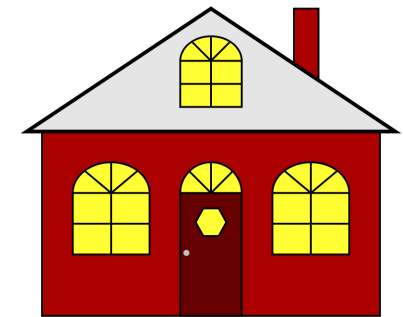

## About

According to Census statistics, Orange County's population more than doubled between 1965 and 2009. Unfortunately, the availability of affordable housing has decreased. RECAP's Supportive Housing programs provide a variety of residences focusing on veterans, seniors, the disabled, and the homeless.

## How it Works

A case manager is matched with each family and meets regularly, in-office and in-home, to help set goals to regain stability and self-sufficiency. Case managers support participants through

- Social service navigation
- Assistance with CPS/APS services
- Help replacing vital documents
- Finding clothes for a job interview
- Securing food
- Furthering education, finding job training
- Updating resumes & interviewing



## Our Residences

### Community Reentry Project

Permanent living apartments in Middletown and Newburgh areas for displaced families.

### Avent House

Furnished rooms in Middletown, including a community room and an on-site resident manager. Resident-developed security program. Facility is gated at night and has 24/7 surveillance, as well as on-site laundry, heat/hot water, and cable available.

### Doris B. Christopher Senior House

Handicapped-accessible housing for men and women. Offers single room occupancies, shared living facilities, and on-site laundry. A resident manager lives on-site to maintain building grounds and offer 24/7 security. RECAP case managers help residents access other supportive services like Meals on Wheels. Heat/hot water and cable available.

### FOCUS Building

A residence for women and children in Middletown. 24/7 security, on-site laundry facility, heat/hot water and cable.

### PACER House

Located in Middletown. Furnished rooms, shared living facilities and a community room for people with special needs including a history of incarceration, addiction and mental health issues. Heat/hot water and cable available.

### Hasbrouck House

Furnished rooms with shared living facilities. Located in Newburgh.



## Eligibility

**For supportive housing or rental assistance, applicants must be income-eligible residents of Orange County, and be homeless or potentially homeless.**

**Applicants must complete the Supportive Housing Application and mail it to the address indicated on the form. Applications can be printed from our website.**



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
